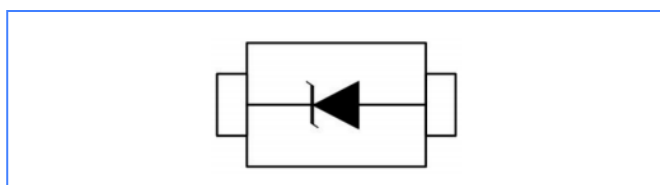

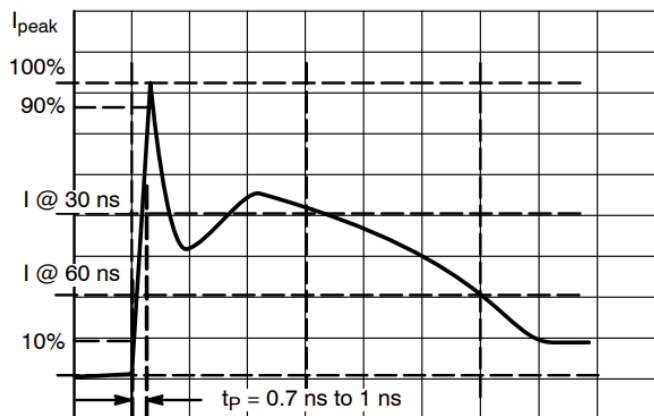

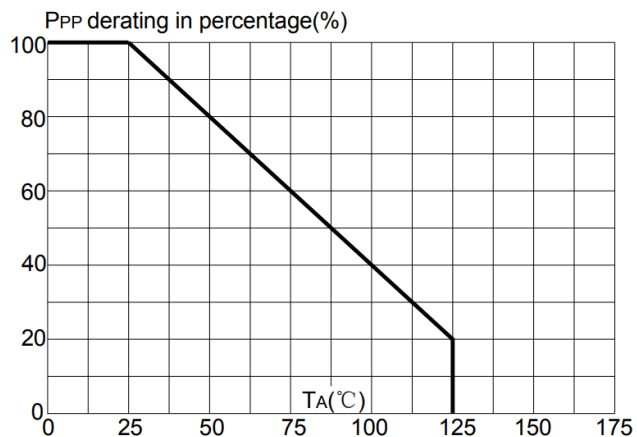

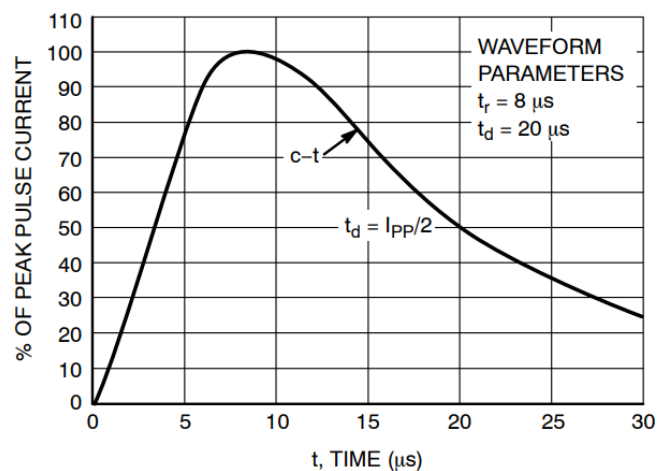
Characteristic Curves



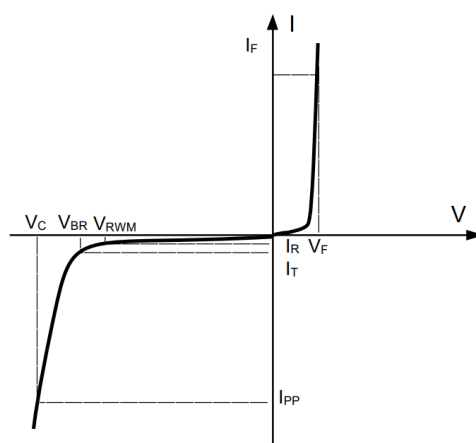
IEC61000-4-2 Pulse Waveform



Power Derating Curve

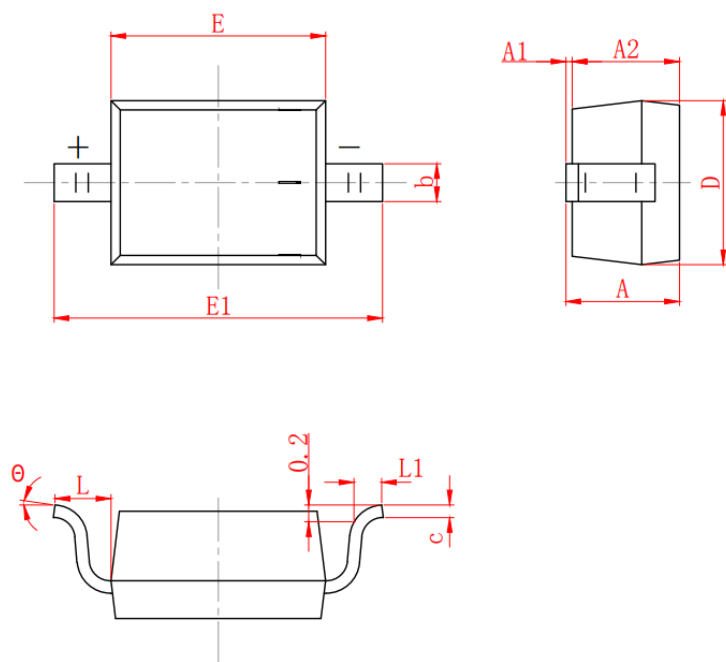


8/20μs Pulse Waveform
